## Fleishman tops Human on clay

Top-seeded Nataly Fleishman defeated Karen Human 6-0, 6-0 yesterday at Glenmore Country Club near Charlottesville to take the women's title in the Virginia State Open clay court championships.

Norfolk's Fleishman, the defending champ, is the head pro at Norfolk Yacht and Country Club. Charlottesville's Human, an assistant pro at Glenmore and former Indiana State player, had upset No. 2 seed Julie Kaczmarek to reach the final.

The men's final pairing was set as No. 1 seed Huntley Montgomery scored a 6-0, 6-1 quarterfinal victory over Simone DeColle, and second-seeded Alex Hume took down Brock Newton 6-1, 6-1 in a quarterfinal and Ramon Bernal 7-6 (7-5), 6-4 in a semifinal. The final will be played at 12:30 this afternoon.

Other quarterfinal results: Raphael Strumlauf d. Peter Szewczyk 6-4, 6-0, and Bernal upset No. 5 Nathan Crick 7-5, 6-3.

## Mid-Atlantic

Second-seeded Lynn Bybee will be seeking his sixth straight title today at noon when he takes on top seed Carl Clark in the Mid-Atlantic men's 40 singles final at the Country Club of Richmond.

Bybee topped Gustavo Pilarte 6-1, 6-1 in one semifinal yesterday, while Clark cruised past third-seeded Leonard Booker 6-0, 6-0 in the other.

The top-seeded doubles team of Chris Blair and Tom Wallace will also be looking for their sixth straight championship at noon today when they face the team of Stuart Chase and Garrett Horsley.

Blair and Wallace dispatched James Cain and Stuart Horsley 6-2, 6-4 in yesterday's semifinals. Chase and Horsley, seeded second, reached the final by beating No. 3 Bryan Bostic and Charles Makepeace 6-3, 6-3.
