#### SUNTRUST STATE CHAMPIONSHIP

Nataly Cahana, the 2002 champion, and Daniel Casquero, runner-up last year, have been installed as the favorites in their respective singles divisions for the SunTrust State Tennis Championships, which open tomorrow at Raintree Swim and Racquet Club.

Cahana, a former No. 1 player at Old Dominion, is followed by No. 2 seed Chrissie Seredni in the field of 15. Last year's champ, Lindsey Wyeth, is seeded third, and Julie Kaczmarek No. 4.

Other top players in the draw include Richmonders Kate Harrington, Joy Fuhr, Margie Walsh, Britt Aspinall and Ginny Wortham.

The men's draw doesn't appear to be as strong as previous years, with several of the leading players either not available or opting to play doubles only.

Former champion Carl Clark is resting up for his appearance in the doubles segment of the Legg Mason Tennis Classic in Washington next month with Trevor Spracklin, while ex-champ Sean Steinour decided to pass up singles and enter two doubles events.

Spracklin, meanwhile, is competing in a satellite event on the professional tour next week.

Following Casquero, who captured the State Clay Court crown recently, in the men's field of 40 are Sears Driscoll, Brent Wilkins, David Emery of Fairfax, John Snead, Sonny Dearth, Darryl Wilburn, Jose Bernard of Manassas and No. 9 Clint Greene.

Other players of interest in the draw include Simon Sjogren, Seth Feibelman, Kevin Long, Adam Moidel, Jesse Tarr, John Lanier Jr. and Randy Loden.

The women's final is slated for 4:30 p.m. Aug. 6, with the men's title match set for 11 a.m. Aug. 7. The winners earn \$1,000 and runners-up receive \$500.

Cahana and Kaczmarek are seeded No. 1 in women's doubles, followed by Wyeth and Rachel Gale, and Walsh-Tami Bigger.

In men's doubles, Sean and Scott Steinour are top-seeded, followed by Clark-Tom Cain, Greene-Joe Cappellino, Casquero- Wilburn, Driscoll-Garrett Horsley and Emery-Snead.
